2. **Understanding of ERC's Mandate and Regulatory Role with stakeholder engagement and institutional independence** (400–600 words)
3. **Assessment of Nepal's Electricity Sector — Current State** (600–800 words)
4. **Top Three Priority Regulatory Agenda with Implementation Plan and Timeline** (1,500–2,000 words)

A simple implementation table structured as follows:

5. **Innovation and Emerging Issues** (500–700 words)

Formatting Guidelines

- Word limit is 5,000 words excluding the implementation table.
- Section word limits are indicative; candidates may adjust within the overall 5,000-word limit but must cover all sections
- The work plan must be the candidate's own work — the presentation and interview will probe specific proposals in depth and candidates should be prepared to defend, elaborate, and critically reflect on everything submitted
