1. INTRODUCTION

Bridge Name Plate Sign Boards are the permanent information signs placed at a bridge sites to identify the rivers/streams/crossings along with the other necessary information like name of the bridge, length of the bridge, no. of spans, bridge reference number, etc. Properly designed and established information boards improve public information, assets management, accountability and heritage value. They also help emergency responders and surveying teams quickly identify the structure in the field.

2. BRIDGE REFERENCING

- The bridges in Provincial Highways (PH) can be coded with PH-XX-YYY-ZZZ. The "PH" denotes the provincial highway, "XX" denotes provincial abbreviation, "YYY" is a serial number of each provincial highway in a province and "ZZZ" is the unique reference number for each bridge. E.g. PH-BG-003-002 represents the bridge in provincial highway-003 in Bagmati Province for bridge no. 002.
- The bridges in Provincial Roads (PR) can be coded with PR-XX-YYY-ZZ which is similar to the bridges on provincial highways. E.g. PR-BG-031-006 represents the bridge in provincial road-031 in Bagmati Province for bridge no. 006.

3. BRIDGE NAME PLATE INFORMATION DETAILS

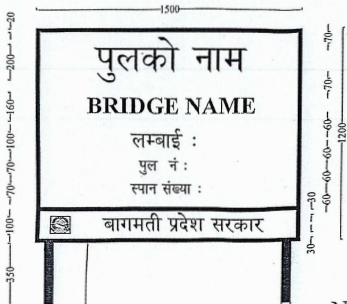
Each bridge name plate information board should contain the following information:

- Name of the Bridge (Both in Devanagari and Roman)
 - Length of the bridge in meter
 - Bridge Referencing
 - No. of spans of the bridge
 - Bagmati Province Government Name (बागमती प्रदेश सरकार) along with Coat of Arms (निशान छाप)
 - Special Instructions if any
- > Name of the bridge is shown on the top of the board followed by length of the bridge, bridge referencing, no. of spans of the bridge and Bagmati Province Government Name along with Coat of Arms respectively.
 - > The bridge referencing will be different for each bridge. Only the last unique reference numerals will be different for the bridges on the same road link.
 - > Different mild steel board should be used to indicate the Bagmati Province Government Name along with the Coat of Arms and should be placed below the main steel board containing the major information (name of bridge, length, referencing and span) in easily accessible places where assembling/welding of the components of the board can be done remotely. (see annex A)
 - > In a place where assembling/welding of the components of the board cannot be done remotely, the single mild steel board can be used to indicate both the major information (name of bridge, length, referencing and span) and the Bagmati Province Government Name along with the Coat of Arms but they should be in different compartments separated by black line. (see annex B)
