The Consulate family participated in a culture promotion event organized by the Shuangliu District Foreign Affairs Office in Chengdu on 12 June. The event '*Echoes of the Snow Peaks: Twin Cities in harmony*' highlighted the musical ties between Chengdu and Kathmandu. One of Nepal's leading folk performers with an educational degree in flute performance, Mr. Ashish Maharjan showcased his musical skills. From the Chinese side, bamboo flute artist Mr. WeiLian performed classical Chinese pieces.

The event also included showing a video on Shuangliu district's history and on Nepal's culture, food, nature and its historic relationship with its northern neighbour. In his remarks, the Consul General highlighted the bond of arts, culture, costumes and cuisine in fostering people-to-people relations and welcomed cultural exchanges of such kind. The director of Shuangliu Foreign Affairs Office Ms .Wang Lichuan was also present.

The venue was decorated with Nepali arts, paintings, pictures, carpets and metal statuettes. A stall for Nepali dumplings '*momo*' and tea was also setup in collaboration with the Consulate. The Consulate also provided for paintings and photos of Nepal's different landscape and culture alongside the video of Nepal played during the event. Over 80 guests including government agencies, music enthusiasts, artists and university students attended the event.
