Our Statement

In order to simplify, organize, and make the driving license acquisition process easier, and to provide better services to service seekers, it has been deemed necessary to simplify the examination system regarding driving license. According to the provisions in Section 49 of the Motor Vehicle and Transport Management Act, 2049 (1992), the Ministry of Physical Infrastructure and Transport (Ministry of Infrastructure development) provided consent on 2077/12/6 B.S. to make the examination process for obtaining a driving license more objective and systematic.

In line with that, the Department of Transport Management implemented the "**Driving License Examination Operating Procedure Guidelines, 2077**" (for Category 'A' – Motorcycle/Scooter/Moped and Category 'B' – Car/Jeep/Delivery Van) starting from **1st Jestha 2078 B.S.**

As per the provisions included in the same guidelines, a **collection of 500 objective questions** was published on the Department's website in the former fiscal year to make the written examination for the above categories more effective and to sensitize the transport policy to public by mandatory learning for examinations. Out of the questions included in this collection, **25 questions** will be asked in the written examination, ensuring representation from all subject areas. Candidates **scoring 60% or above** will be considered as passed.

The practical examination will include the stages as specified by the guidelines. Candidates **scoring 70% or more** (depends on the TMOs Policy and Provincial Law as well) in this exam will be considered as passed. To ensure that only competent individuals pass, some parts of the practical test have been made easier, while some stages have been made mandatory.

The guidelines received approval from the Government of Nepal, Ministry of Physical Infrastructure and Transport by the ministerial level decision on **2078/03/08 B.S.** and were first amended by the Department on **2078/04/07 B.S.**

Incorporating the revised provisions, this new and updated question collection has been published by further refining the one released last year. It is believed that this will help service seekers to more easily access this vital service under transport services for the **obtaining of a driving license.**

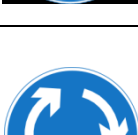

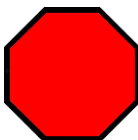
