Her Excellency Ms. Sumnima Tuladhar, Ambassador of Nepal to the Kingdom of Denmark presented her Letters of Credence to His Majesty Frederik Andre Henrik Christian, the King of Denmark amid a special ceremony held today at Christiansborg Palace, Copenhagen.

Following the presentation of credentials, Ambassador was granted an audience with His Majesty the King. On the occasion, Her Excellency Ambassador conveyed warm greetings and best wishes on behalf of Rt. Hon'ble Ram Chandra Paudel, President of Nepal and the Prime Minister Rt. Hon'ble K.P. Sharma Oli for His Majesty's continued good health and happiness as well as for the sustained prosperity and well-being of the People of Denmark.

His Majesty the King extended his congratulations to Ambassador Tuladhar on her appointment and conveyed his best wishes for a successful tenure as an Ambassador of Nepal to Denmark.

During the audience, various dimensions of the bilateral relationship between Nepal and Denmark were discussed. His Majesty the King fondly recalled his visit to Nepal in 2015, following the devastating earthquake, during which he oversaw humanitarian relief efforts in the western regions of the country. Ambassador Tuladhar emphasized the importance of further strengthening the bilateral ties between Nepal and Denmark. His Majesty also expressed concern regarding climate change and its detrimental effects on the Himalayan region. In response, Ambassador Tuladhar briefed His Majesty on the forthcoming 'Sagarmatha Sambaad – Everest Dialogue,' an international forum to be held in Nepal aimed at addressing the alarming rate of glacial melting and its consequences for mountain communities.

Members of the Royal Court, Mr. Gauri Pradhan, Spouse of the Ambassador and diplomats of the Embassy of Nepal were also present at the Credentials Ceremony.
