FLOOD DISASTER IN NEPAL & APPEAL FOR SUPPORT

Ref. Following the devastating flash floods in Bhote Koshi, Trishuli and Narayani River area of Rasiwa, Nuwakot, Gorkha and Dhading districts of Nepal on 26 August 2026, the Government of Nepal has mobilized all available resources and efforts at its disposal for search, rescue, and relief and recovery operations, with particular attention to people who remain missing, including both Nepali and foreign nationals. الإشارة

The Government's immediate national priority remains clear: ***to save lives, locate and rescue missing persons, provide urgent relief to survivors, and ensure that affected Nepali as well as foreigner receive appropriate assistance and support.***

So far, 903 bodies have been recovered from the areas and about more than 4247 people are still missing, including 592 foreign nationals are still missing.

The operations on the ground are carried out effectively, and the figures concerning casualties, missing persons and damage continue to change as search and verification operations continue.

Many foreign nationals are still missing. So, a dedicated Emergency Control Room at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has been established to coordinate with relevant agencies as well as with the families of missing people.

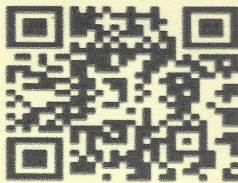

MECHANISMS FOR SENDING SUPPORT TO PRIME MINISTER DISASTER RELIEF FUND

Nepalese residing abroad, Non-resident Nepalese, and foreign nationals/institutions willing to donate or send relief fund to designated PM Relief Fund Accounts can use the following instruments/systems/mechanisms:

1. Using Card Payment Gateway

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2. Scanning Domestic QR Codes

Users of Alipay+, along with 12 wallets interoperable with Alipay+, and users of Unified Payments Interface (UPI)-India can scan the following QR codes linked to PM Relief Fund Account:

b. NepalPAY QR (Alipay+ Only)

3. Fund Transfer through UPI from India

UPI-India users can remit funds to designated PM Relief Fund Accounts using cross-border P2P fund transfer option available in UPI-enabled applications of Indian Banks.

4. Fund Transfer through SWIFT (Worldwide)

People residing abroad can use SWIFT to transfer funds to designated PM Relief Fund Accounts either by visiting their respective bank or using the fund transfer option available in their internet banking system.
