I would like to thank the officials of Establishment Census and Survey Section who have prime role in implementing and managing the survey. I heartily appreciate members of Hotel Association of Nepal, Hotel Federation of Nepal, Restaurant and Bar Association Nepal, Homestay Association Nepal, Hostel Association Nepal who supported the survey process and all other well-wishers whose feedbacks and suggestions contributed to make this survey a success. 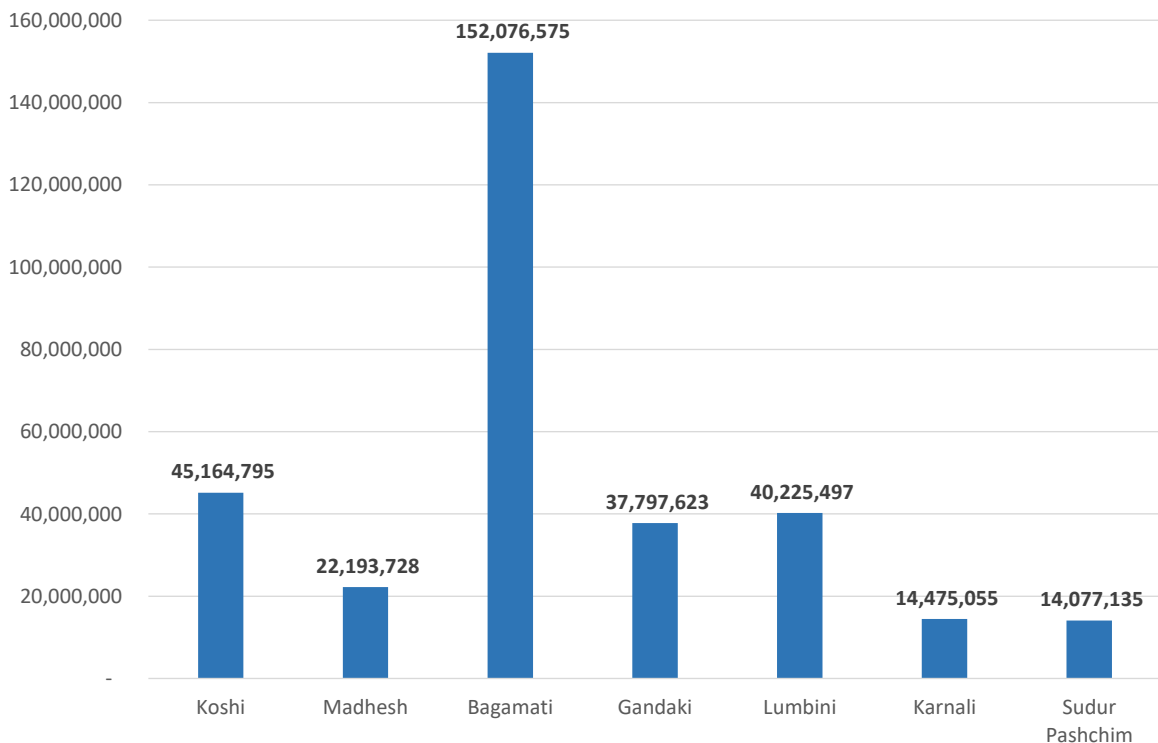


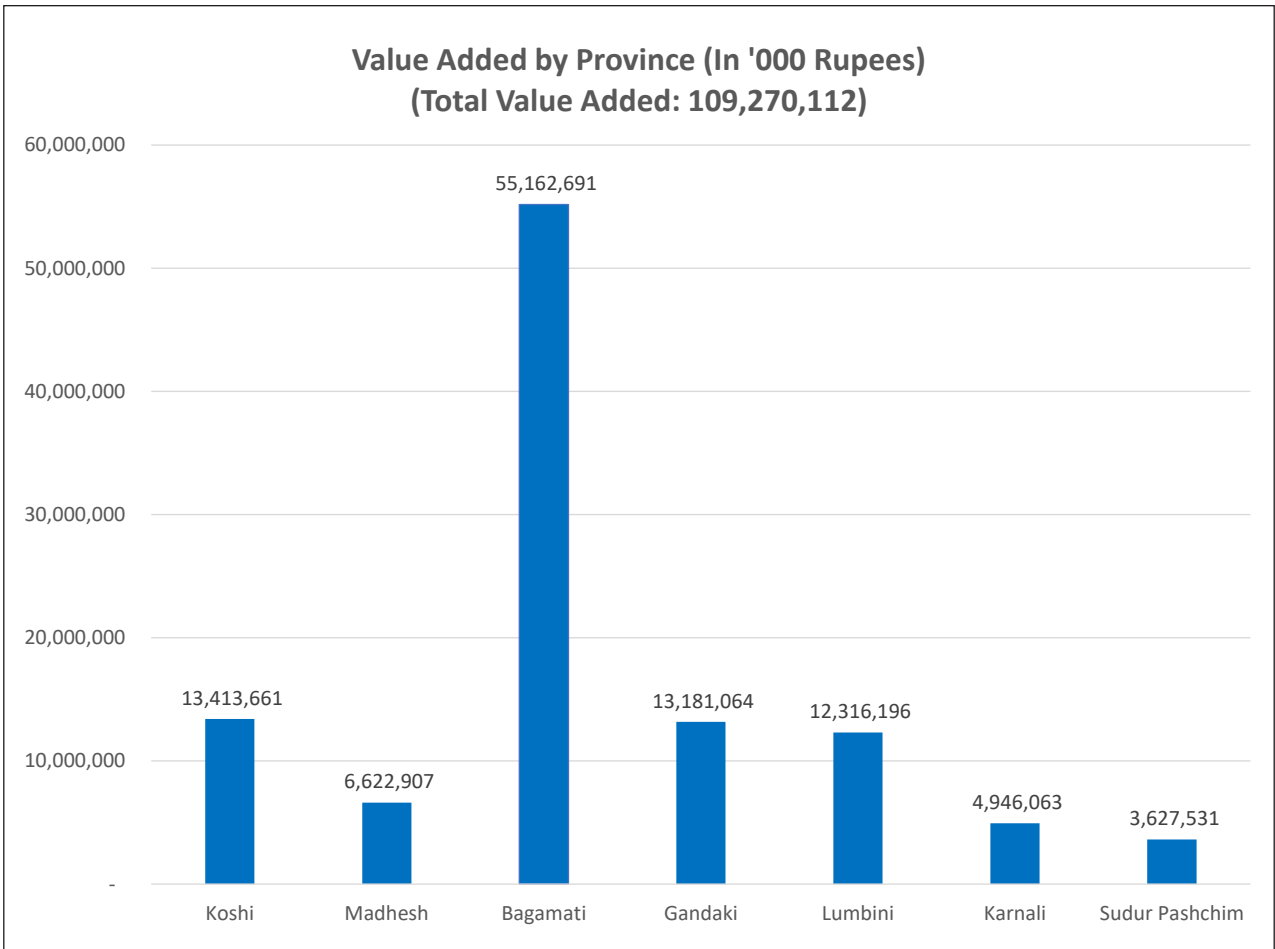
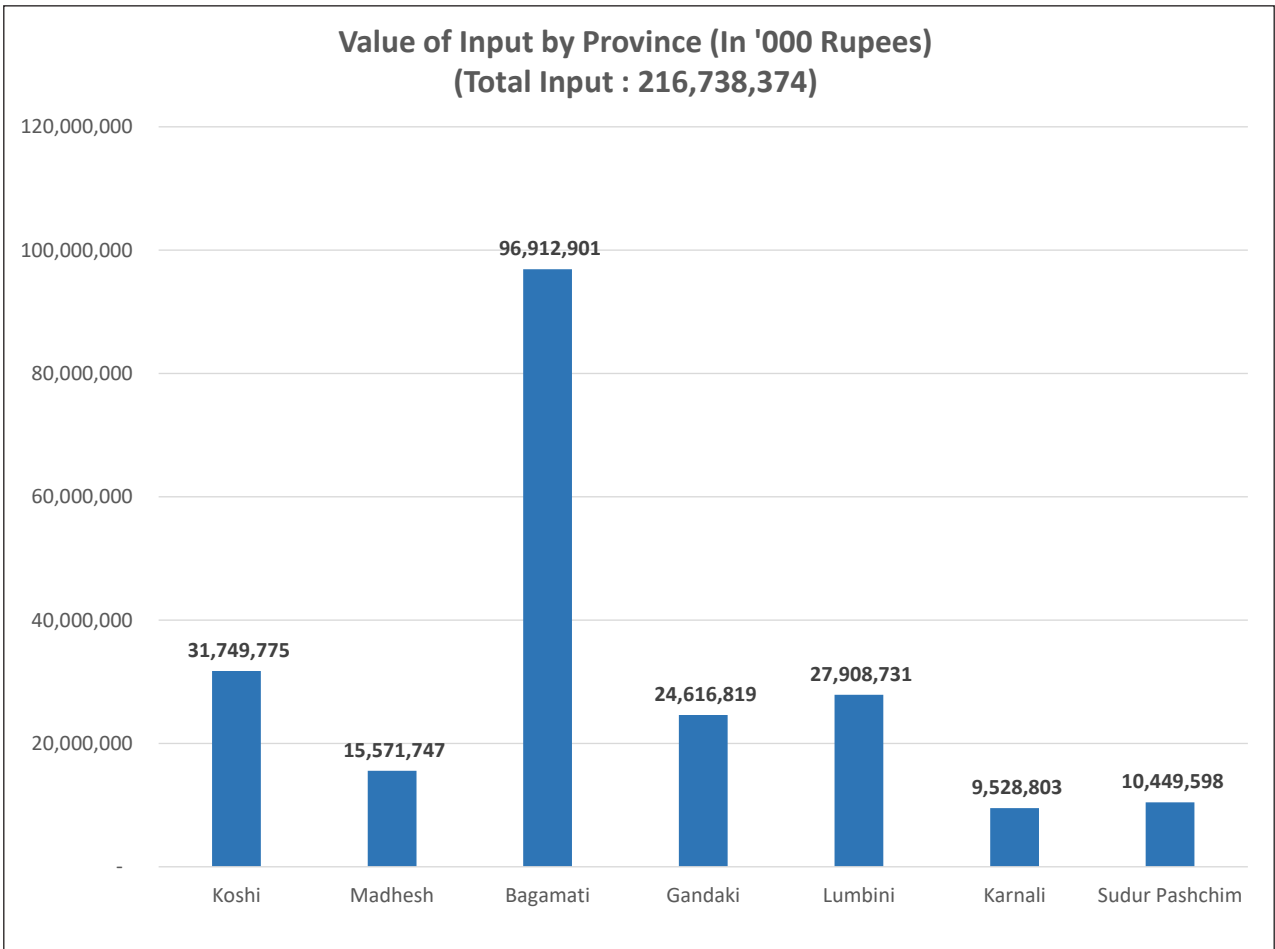


Gross Fixed Assets at the End of the Year by Province (In '000 Rupees)
 (Total Assets: 543,258,209)

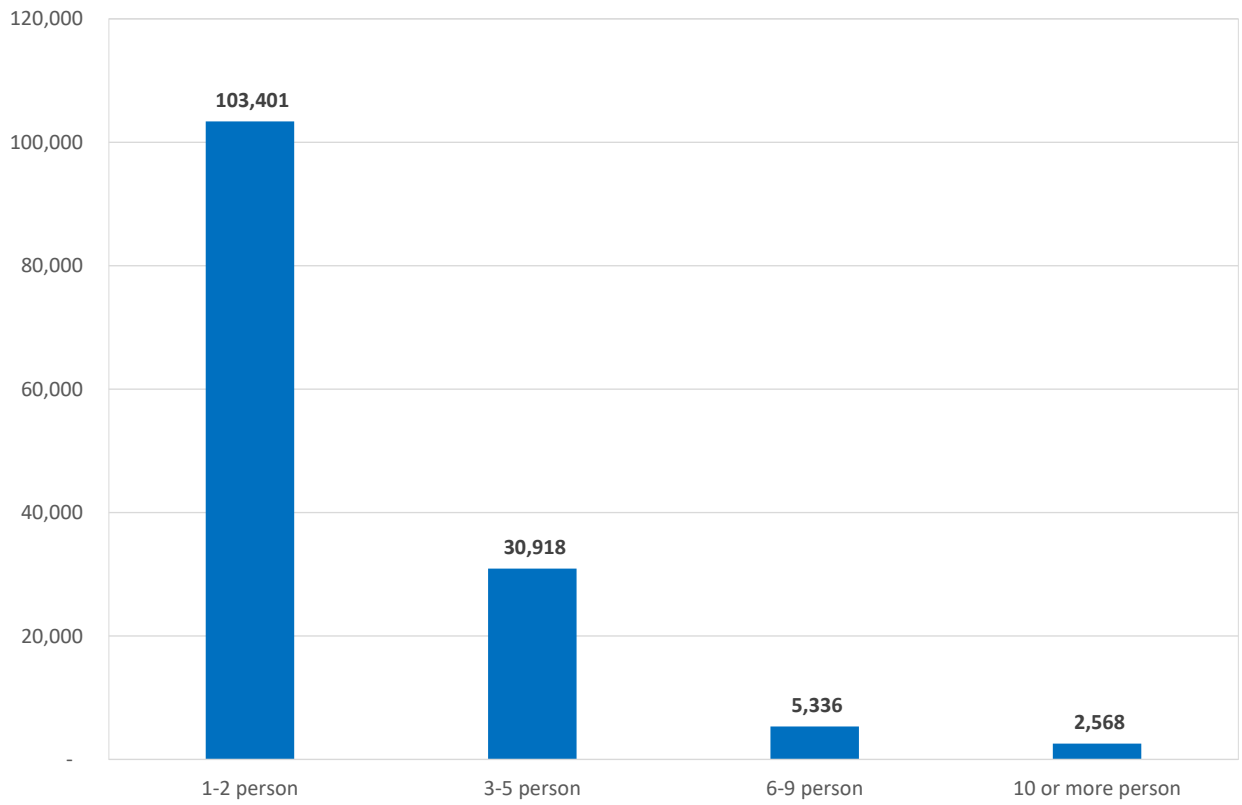


Value of Output by Province (In '000 Rupees)
 (Total Output : 326,010,408)

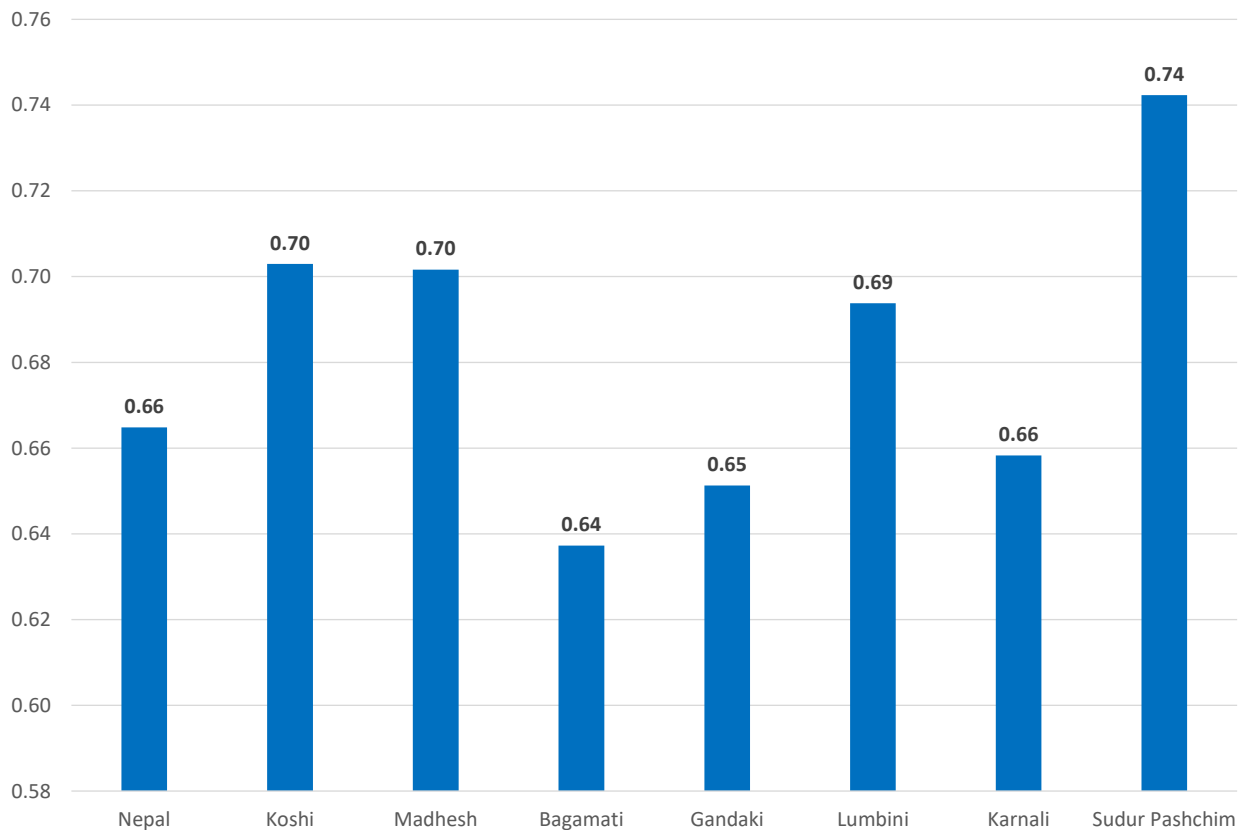




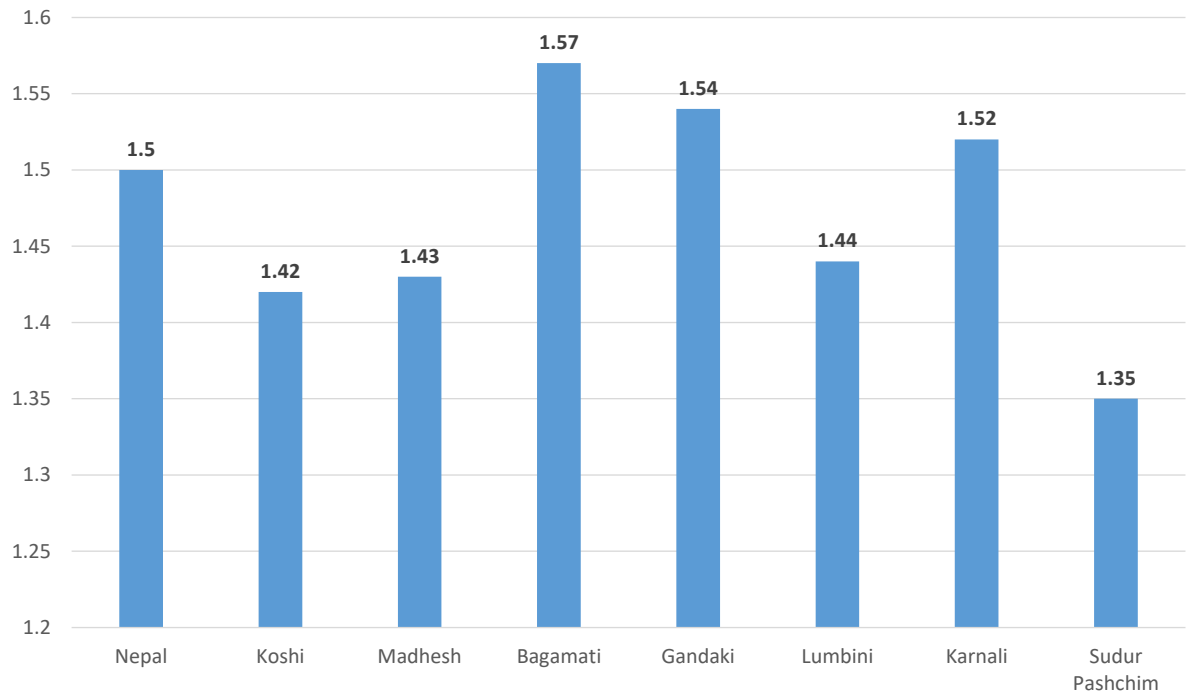
Number of Establishments by Persons Engaged
(Total : 142,223)



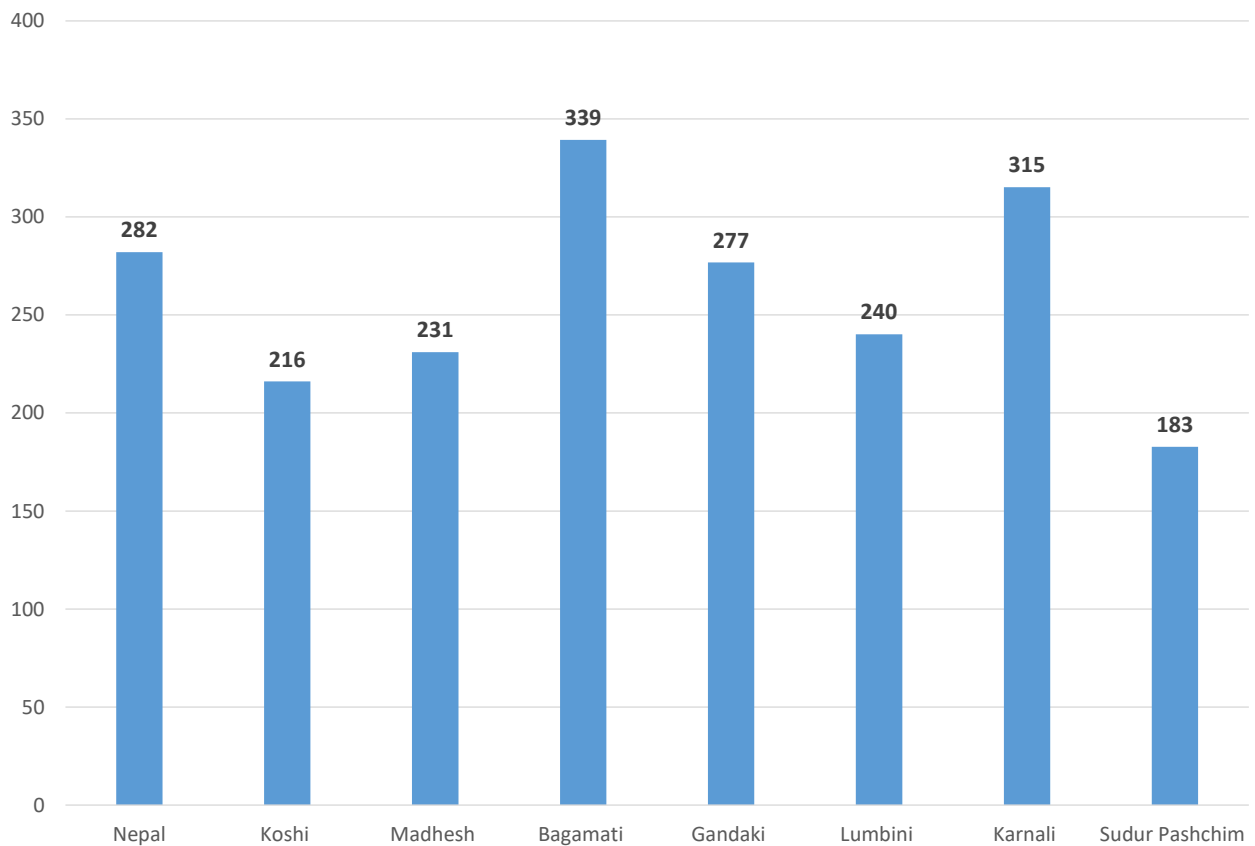
Input Output Ratio by Province



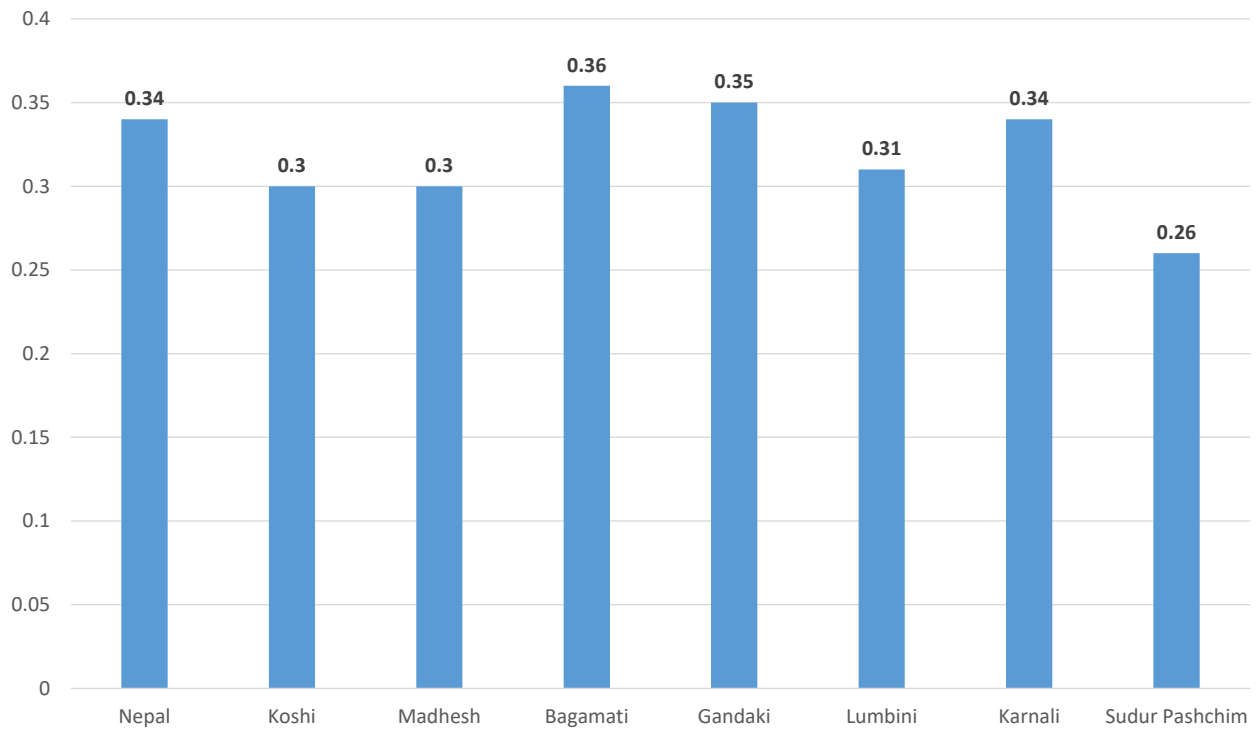
Output Input Ratio by Province



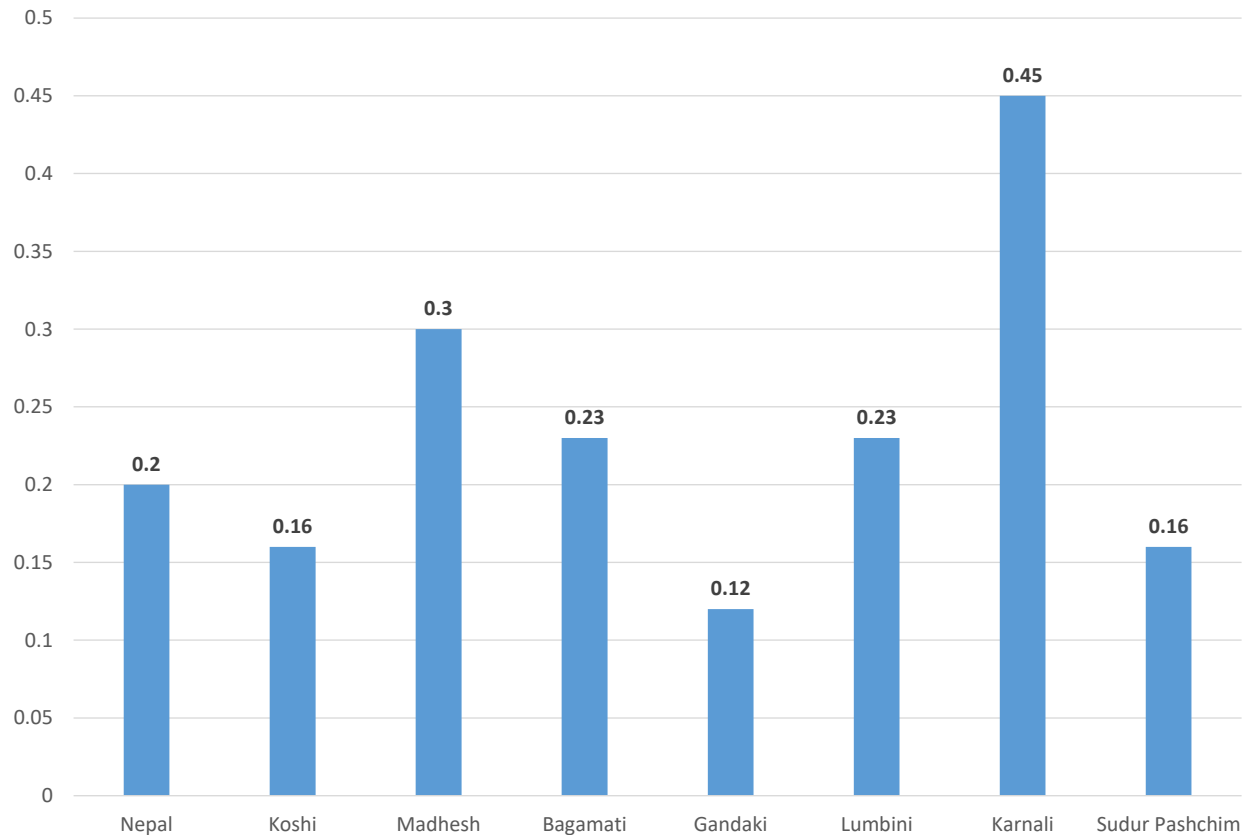
Value Added per Person Engaged by Province (In '000 Rupees)

CHAPTER I

SURVEY METHODOLOGY

1.1 Introduction

The International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) categorizes economic activities into 21 industries. Among these, accommodation and food service is a key economic activity, classified under Section "I" of the ISIC. This section is further divided into 2 divisions (2-digit classification), 6 groups (3-digit classification), and 7 classes (4-digit classification). The 4-digit classifications include:

- Short-term accommodation activities (5510)
- Camping grounds, recreational vehicle parks, trailer parks (5520)
- Other accommodation (5590)
- Restaurant and mobile food services (5610)
- Event catering (5621)
- Other food service activities (5629)
- Beverage service activities (5630)

The National Statistics Office (NSO) produces industry-wise National Account estimates and other macroeconomic indicators for the country. According to the NSO (2024), the agriculture sector holds the largest GDP share at 23.92%, while the accommodation and food service sector contributes around 1.96% to the total GDP.

The development of the accommodation and food service sector is vital not only for the growth of this industry but also for its impact on related sectors such as tourism, transportation, and communication. This growth supports poverty alleviation through employment generation and income expansion. Reliable statistical information is crucial for understanding the current status of this sector and for formulating and evaluating plans and programs of this sector effectively. Keeping this in mind, the NSO collects and disseminates official statistics on accommodation and food service through censuses and surveys.

Nepal has a relatively short history of conducting surveys on accommodation and food service activities. The first "Hotel and Lodge" study was conducted in 2003/04, covering only star hotels, resorts, lodges, and non-star hotels. The first comprehensive National Hotel and Restaurant Survey (NHRS) 2023/24, based on the ISIC Rev. 4 classification, was conducted to cover all the activities in the accommodation and food service sector in Nepal.

In this survey, all star hotels and resorts were fully enumerated, while other establishments (such as non-star hotels, restaurants, party palaces, hostels, and homestays) were sampled. The survey

provides detailed information on the number of establishments, total employees, wages/salaries, inputs/outputs, and other relevant data about the accommodation and food service sector in Nepal. National Hotel and Restaurant Survey 2023/24 is important for its comprehensive scope and coverage, making it the first survey in this scale on accommodation and food service sector.

1.2 Objectives

The primary objective of the National Hotel and Restaurant Survey is to provide detail information on status and characteristics of accommodation and food service activities in the country for policymakers, planners, researchers, stakeholders, communities, and other users.

The specific objectives are to provide:

- The basic structure of the accommodation and food service industry (establishments) operating during the reference period by provinces.
- Statistics on employment in the accommodation and food service sector by provinces.
- Input/output structures of the accommodation and food service sector by provinces.
- Statistics on the accommodation and food service industry categorized by NSIC and provinces.
- Information on various aspects of the accommodation and food service industry.

1.3 Reference Period

The reference period for the National Hotel and Restaurant Survey, 2023/24 was 17 July 2022 to 16 July 2023 (fiscal year 2079/80 BS). However, for collecting data on the number of persons engaged in establishments, the reference date was set as 15 January 2023 (1 Magh 2079).

1.4 Survey Scope

The survey included all economic activities under Section "I" of ISIC/NSIC based on the following criteria:

- **Registered establishments:** All establishments registered with at least one among many government entity were included in the survey.
- **Unregistered establishments:** All establishments not registered with any government entity but engaged in accommodation and food service activities were also included.

In summary, the survey covered all establishments, whether registered or unregistered, engaged in accommodation and food service activities and in operation within the reference period. The detailed list of economic activities covered is provided in Annex 1.

1.5 Enumeration Unit

The enumeration unit for the National Hotel and Restaurant Survey, 2023/24 was defined as an "establishment" performing accommodation and food service activities during the reference period.

For the purpose of this survey, an establishment was defined as follows:

"An establishment is an economic unit operating under a single ownership or control i.e., a single legal entity engaged in one or predominantly one type of economic activity as defined in Section 'I: Accommodation and Food Service Activities' of the NSIC."

1.6 Survey Questionnaires and Manuals

Single questionnaire was administered for the data collection. The questionnaire was initially drafted by Establishment Census and Survey Section of NSO and finalized with intensive discussion with stakeholders in different level (Federal and Provinces). The major stakeholders participated in discussion programs were government ministries, departments and private sectors such as Hotel Association of Nepal (HAN), Hotel Professional Federation Nepal (HPFN), Restaurant and Bar Association Nepal (REBAN), Hostel Association Nepal, Homestay Federation Nepal.

The major areas covered by questionnaires are as follows.

Contents of the questionnaire:

- Introductory information about establishments,
- Business information about establishments,
- Employment,
- Expenditure of the establishments
- Income of the establishments,
- Stocks,
- Information of fixed assets,
- Information on loan, source of loan, reasons for not taking loan, social security, management of garbage, corporate social responsibility (CSR), human/non-human accident and lose, and
- Factors affecting business environment of the establishment.

The survey questionnaire is given in annex 2.

A comprehensive data collection manual based on the questionnaire was also prepared. The manual was used by enumerators and supervisors while collecting data. The concepts and definitions of technical terms, methodology and objective of the survey and aim of each question in the questionnaire were explained in the manual.

1.7 Sample Design

1.7.1 Sampling Frame

The frame of the survey was developed basically from the list of the National Economic Census (NEC) 2018. The list of establishments from NEC 2018 contains the complete name and address of establishments along with other variables such as annual income, annual expenditure, number of persons engaged etc.

Before deciding sampling methodology, the nature and characteristics of NEC 2018 frame was reviewed and considered it as a main frame. Besides the main frame, the lists of currently running star hotels, resorts, hostels, homestay, catering and party palace were updated to the main-frame. Those lists were obtained from Department of tourism, Hotel Association of Nepal (HAN), Hostel Association, Homestay Federation, and from other associations. The entire updated list/frame was also adjusted during field work, which was the complete frame of the survey.

1.7.2 Stratification

Separate survey scheme was designed for each NSIC covered in the survey. Star hotels and resorts were completely enumerated as they were small in number but usually have high value of transactions. In case of other types of establishments, complete enumeration and sampling method were adopted based on the following criteria.

- For large sized establishments (if number of persons engaged was more than or equal to 10), all establishments were enumerated except for those belonging to Kathmandu, Lalitpur, Chitwan, Kaski and Rupendehi. For these districts, sampling method was adopted.
- For small sized establishments (if number of persons engaged was less or equal to 9), sampling method was adopted. However, if number of establishments in each province at 3 digit NSIC level and person engaged category, was less than 30, then such establishments were completely enumerated to ensure their representation in the survey. Despite this consideration, if the number of establishments enumerated is less than the total number, weights are assigned accordingly.

For small sized establishments, three categories were made based on number of persons engaged i.e. 1-2 persons engaged, 3-5 persons engaged and 6-9 persons engaged.

Using these person engaged categories, strata were made based on province, NSIC group and persons engaged categories. The total number of establishments in the sampling frame for small size establishments by province is presented in Table A.

1.7.3 Analytical Domain

The survey was designed to provide the national and provincial estimates of the NSIC 4 digits classification.

1.7.4 Sample Size and Sampling Method

The survey's total enumeration size (both census and survey) was planned to enumerate 7,557 establishments. Out of them, 7,277 establishments were enumerated in the survey.

For small size establishments, a total of 6,419 establishments were fixed as a sample size, which were distributed to each stratum (province, NSIC, persons engaged category) using power allocation with power 0.6. The samples from each stratum were then selected by using systematic sampling method. The summary of sample allocation is presented in the table B.

1.8 Steering and Technical Committees

Steering and technical committees were formed for smooth operation of the activities of NHRS 2023/24. The steering committee was chaired by the Chief Statistician of the National Statistics Office (NSO) including members representing from concerned ministries, Tribhuvan University (TU), and different association of stakeholders. The main function of steering committee was to facilitate and to coordinate with concerned agencies for successful implementation of the survey. In addition, this committee approved the survey questionnaires and survey manual as well. The composition of the steering committee is presented in annex 5A.

National Hotel and Restaurant Survey Technical Committee was also formed with the chairmanship of the Deputy Chief Statistician (DCS) of the Economic Statistics Division of the NSO. Representatives from concerned ministries and departments, Section of NSO, and concerned stakeholders were the member of this committee. The main function of this committee is to provide technical inputs on the survey such as questionnaire/survey manual preparation, sample design and to recommend them for approvals to the steering committee. The composition of the technical committee is presented in annex 5B.

1.9 Survey Organization

The Establishments Census and Survey Section (ECSS), under the Economic Statistics Division of NSO, worked as a central level working team for conducting the survey. ECSS has 1 (previously 2) Directors, 3 Statistics Officers, 1 Computer Officer and 1 Statistical Assistant. During the survey, 33 Statistics Offices located at 33 districts of NSO played vital role for coordinating with the district level stakeholders and for successful implementation of the survey.

The field work was conducted for about 4 months to collect the data. In total, about 20% of enumerators were hired in contractual basis by respective Statistics Offices. The field work of enumerators was supervised jointly by NSO and Statistics Offices.

1.10 Trainings

Various level training programs were organized by NSO for successful implementation of the survey. This included MToT, officer and enumerator level training. The ECSS of NSO organized 3 days MToT training program, with main objective of preparing the resource persons for the officer level and enumerator level training. The participants of the MToT were mainly Directors from NSO. Likewise, three days Officer Training was conducted in two districts. The participants were directors and statistics officers of the district offices.

Similarly, five days training program for enumerator was conducted in three districts. The theoretical as well as practical aspects of the survey and its questionnaire were the main contents of the trainings.

1.11 Field Operation

Field operation was planned at second week of April 2023 (first week of Chaitra 2080) and targeted to complete in 4 months. As per schedule, the field operation was started all over the country and completed as scheduled.

1.12 Inter-agency Coordination and Publicity

Coordination among the different agencies is considered an essential factor for successfully implementation of the survey. Publicity campaign is another important aspect that informs and educates the accommodation and food service industries (establishments), business people and the general public about the importance of the accommodation and food service sector statistics in the national statistical system. The following activities were undertaken in connection with Inter-agency coordination and publicity campaign of the survey.

a. Inter-agency Coordination

- A request letter was sent by the concerned Ministry and Departments to coordinate the field operation of NHRS 2023/24 to their provincial and local level offices.
- Professional Associations: Hotel Association Nepal, Hotel Professional Federation Nepal, Restaurant and Bar Association of Nepal, Hostel Association Nepal, Homestay Federation Nepal requested to their members in district level to provide accurate and timely information to enumerators.

- A request letter from NSO was handed over to each establishment to cooperate and support enumerators by providing accurate information in time as outlined in the questionnaire.

b. Publicity Campaign:

- A central level inception seminar was organized before the field work. Representatives from the concerned ministries, departments, FNCCI, and other stakeholder`s organization participated in the seminar. The main objective of the seminar was to inform and aware about the ongoing Hotel and Restaurant survey.
- Similarly, province level inception seminar was conducted in seven provinces to inform and aware them about the ongoing survey. Representatives from related provincial ministries, offices and stakeholder's organization participated in the seminar.
- Some Statistics offices organized half day awareness seminar in districts. The main objective of this event was to inform and aware local stakeholders about the ongoing survey.

1.13 Data Processing

After the accomplishment of the field operation, the filled up questionnaires were initially edited by heads of Statistics Offices in each district and then enumerators who collected/filled up the questionnaires, entered the data at their respective Statistics Office. The data entry application was developed by the ECSS of NSO by using CPro application. During the data entry, the ECSS daily monitored and guided the operators if they had delusion and made mistake in data entry. All the entered data were synchronized by operators in daily basis for the further processing to NSO. Data analysis and tabulation was done by using STATA and IBM SPSS in some extents.

Standard coding system adopted by NSO, had been used for coding. For industry classification, ISIC/ NSIC Revision 4 was used at the 4 digit level. Likewise, for service product classification, the CPC version 2.1 was used at the 4 digit level. The coding, editing and data entry activities were supervised by officials of the ECSS of NSO.

1.14 Missing Establishment

In total, 126 star hotels were observed in the survey. Among the total 186 star hotels in a Frame (as per the Department of Tourism), some of them closed their business after the COVID pandemic. Likewise, some of them were under the renovation/construction during the reference period, some star hotels were converted to resort/hotel/hostel types.

Around 3.7 percent establishments were missing. Those missing establishments were treated by adjusting the sampling weight.

1.15 Limitations

- NHRS 2023/24 is primarily based on the frame of NEC 2018. An attempt was also made to update the frame from other official records from Department of Tourism, Professional Associations like: HAN, HPFN, Hostel Association, and Homestay Federation.
- The survey was conducted on the basis of the predominant economic activities. Establishments which carried more than one economic activity and could not separate out their transaction by individual activities such as food and beverage service establishment which carry out both food and beverage service and event catering service activities. In such cases, if food and beverage service is predominant activity then both activities were accounted in beverage service.

1.16 Summary of Principal Indicators

The National Hotel and Restaurant Survey (NHRS) 2023/24, provides the detail information on number of establishments, employments (engaged and employee), wages and salary, value of fixed assets at the end of the year, value of input, value of output and value added. These information are considered as principal indicators of the survey.

This survey disclosed the total number of establishments of section "I" of NSIC is 142,223 where 387,747 persons are engaged at national level. Out of total persons engaged; 106,459 are paid employees and 281,228 are proprietors as well as unpaid family workers. Likewise, the expense on wage and salary is NRs. 20.615 billion, value of fixed assets at the end of the year is NRs. 543.258 billion, and value of output during reference period is NRs. 326.010 billion. In addition to this, these establishments generated NRs. 109.27 billion as total value added in the reference year. The details of the principal indicators by province are presented in Table C.

1.17 Summary of Performance Indicators

In the context of accommodation and food service activity, performance indicators measure the economic efficiency of accommodation and food service industries with respect to growth of output in relative term of input. These indicators help to evaluate the economic situation of this sector and use for planning and implementing an effective fiscal and monetary policy. Performance indicator is an outcome of various social, economic and technological factors.

Particularly, in the context of accommodation and food service activity, performance indicators measure the economic efficiency of accommodation and food service industries. The top three important dimensions of industrial performance are productivity, structural change, and competitiveness. Among these three dimensions, productivity has been described below.

Productivity is a ratio of volume measure of output to a volume measure of input use or it is derived from the ratio of value of real output to value of input over a period of time. Productivity can be measured in different ways, depending on the definition of output and input components or measures. Input as a percentage of output, Output/input ratio, value added per employee, Value added output ratio, and value added per unit of capital are the important partial productivity indicators.

a) Input as a Percentage of Output: It measures input per 100 outputs of industrial establishments. Higher the value of the indicator, more use of inputs and lowers the value of the indicator, less use of inputs for producing 100 outputs.

b) Output Input Ratio: Output input ratio is a ratio of volume of output to the volume of input use. This ratio indicator measures the output per unit of input and also measures the efficiency of use of inputs. Higher the value of indicator indicates the efficient use of inputs, similarly lower the value of indicator indicates the inefficient use of inputs.

c) Valued Added Per Person Engaged: Value added per person engaged is a measure of labour productivity in accommodation and food service industry. It indicates the average amount of value added produced by per person engaged. This is the simplest approximation of rate of labour productivity in service industry. When labour is more skilled or when more capital is used by labour, this will result in a higher value added. Labour productivity thus provides a mixed measure of labour skills and capital intensity.

d) Value Added Output Ratio: The value added output ratio measures efficiency of the use of inputs. It can be calculated at any level (for example: at sectors and sub-sectors level, as well as at enterprise or establishment level). Since it is a ratio between two values, the effects of inflation are nearly eliminated and making the value added output ratio a more stable and robust estimate in comparison with the absolute value of output and input. Thus, it is widely used in order to check the data consistency in survey results.

e) Value Added Per Unit of Capital: It is the ratio of value added to the capital. Here, capital refers to the value of gross fixed assets at the end of reference period. Value added per unit of capital measures the efficiency and effectiveness of fixed assets in the generation of output of the service sector as well as its sub-sectors. Lower the value of indicator indicates the inefficient use of capital or poor marketing while higher the value of indicator indicates the efficient capital utilization or good marketing.

Based on this principal, aforementioned performance indicators of the accommodation and food service industry, is derived and presented in Table D.

 - d. Tradable goods (i.e. goods sold in the same condition as purchased).
- 10. Change in Value of Total Stocks:** Value of total stocks at the end of the year less value of total stocks at the beginning of the year.
- 11. Income From Accommodation and Food Services (Sales of Goods and Services):** amount received from sale of accommodation and food services;
- a. room revenue ,

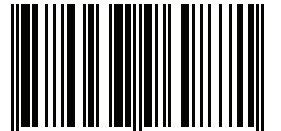
