

#### Preamble

Education Review Office founded in 2010 is a single independent agency to review educational outcomes in Nepal. The Government of Nepal has exclusively awarded two legal mandates to this office that include a) conducting national assessment of students' performance within the entire school system and b) undertaking performance audit of schools and educational organizations under the ministry system. This office has upgraded its professional strength by utilizing experience of continued operations for the past 15 years.

The most visible and realizable achievement of this agency so far, are stablishing a practice of national assessment of students' achievement and creating a system for performance audit of educational institutions and programs. The 'assessment' and 'audit' functions aim at enhancing public accountability and at generating genuine pressure for systematic reform in education system.

In order for contributing to realize the aforesaid aims, this journal was initiated a few years ago. The principal objective of the journal is to establish and disseminate an applied knowledge of the assessment and the audit based on the practical experiences as well as statistical evidences. For this, the journal articles are expected to be reasonably professional and firmly tailored to meet the objective. Therefore, ERO officially intends to circulate an indicative Journal Guidelines in order for facilitating the authors to prepare responsive articles.

#### Process of Peer Review

As soon as manuscripts are submitted by authors to the editorial board, there will be an initial review (scrutiny) of them. If they are found to have maintained the level as indicated in the above guidelines, they will be sent to the peer reviewers. Feedback from the peer reviewers will be forwarded to the respective authors for improving the manuscripts. The manuscripts with unsatisfactory revisions will be rejected.

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
