4. Electronic Bids must be submitted to the Department of Health Services, Management Division, Teku, Kathmandu, Nepal through <https://bolpatra.gov.np/egp> on or before **13:00 Hour on 21 July 2026**.
5. Bids shall be opened in presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend on **13:10 Hour on 21 July 2026** at the office of Department of Health Services, Management Division, Teku, Kathmandu, Nepal.
6. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days counting from the day of bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security of **NPR. 250,000.00** which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the bid validity period (i.e., **valid up to 18 November 2026**). If the last date of opening falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered the last day. In such a case the bid validity and bid security validity shall be recognized with effect from the original bid submission deadline.
7. In the case of discrepancies or error in bid documents, bid notice or any other document, the DOHS reserve the right to amend and correct at any time.
