Invitation for Expression of Interest

“Know Your Embassy: Nepali Students Connect 2026”

The Embassy of Nepal in New Delhi invites expressions of interest from Nepali students currently studying at recognized universities, colleges, research institutions and other higher educational institutions across all States and Union Territories of India (Except Delhi NCR) to participate in “**Know Your Embassy: Nepali Students Connect 2026.**”

The program is being organized as part of the Embassy’s outreach to Nepali students in India. It aims to familiarize students with the roles, functions and services of the Embassy, strengthen communication between the Embassy and the Nepali student community, and encourage young Nepalis to contribute to the promotion of Nepal and the strengthening of Nepal-India people-to-people relations.

The program is guided by three central messages:

- **The Embassy is your home away from home.**
- **Nepali students are ambassadors of Nepal in India.**
- **Youth can strengthen Nepal-India people-to-people relations.**

1. Objectives

The program seeks to:

- i. Introduce students to the mandate, functions and services of the Embassy;
- ii. Provide an opportunity for direct interaction with Embassy officials;
- iii. Strengthen communication and coordination between the Embassy and Nepali students;
- iv. Encourage student participation in cultural, tourism and public diplomacy activities;
- v. Identify interested volunteers for the proposed **Nepal-India Student Ambassador Network (NISAN)**; and
- vi. Promote interaction and networking among Nepali students from different institutions.

2. Nepal-India Student Ambassador Network (NISAN)

The Nepal-India Student Ambassador Network (NISAN) is a voluntary youth platform of the Embassy of Nepal in New Delhi connecting Nepali students studying in India. It will serve as a bridge between the Embassy and the student community by sharing official information, supporting student welfare, promoting Nepal, and assisting in cultural, tourism and public diplomacy activities. NISAN will also encourage student networking and strengthen Nepal-India people-to-people relations. Participation will be honorary and voluntary and will not confer any formal diplomatic, consular or official representative status.

3. Eligibility

Students enrolled in undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral, professional or other recognized higher education programs are eligible to apply. Applicants must:

- Be Nepali citizens currently enrolled in a recognized higher educational institution in India with a valid student identity card;

- Have an interest in community engagement, public diplomacy, cultural promotion or Nepal-India relations; and

5. Selection Process

Selection will be based on:

- Interest in student and community engagement;
- Representation from different universities and institutions;
- Diversity of academic disciplines and levels of study; and
- The need to ensure inclusive and balanced participation.

Only selected applicants from all states and union territories of India (Except Delhi NCR) will be contacted for zoom meeting through the email address or telephone number provided in the registration form. Participation is personal and non-transferable.

- The Embassy reserves the right to modify the program schedule or selection arrangements, if necessary.
- The decision of the Embassy regarding selection will be final.
- The title '*Nepal-India Student Ambassador*' is honorary and voluntary and does not confer any official diplomatic, consular or representative status.
