



Embassy of Nepal in Bahrain hosted a “Nepal Tourism and Business Networking Event”

On 13 July 2025, the Embassy of Nepal in Manama, Bahrain, hosted an event on the theme “Nepal Tourism and Business Networking Event” at the Crowne Plaza in Manama. The event aimed to promote Nepal’s tourism and business via networking and engagement with the Bahraini government officials, business leaders, investors, tour/travel companies, journalists and media.

The guests were also introduced to the diverse tourist attractions in Nepal through the displayed banners and tourism promotional videos including videos promoting Nepali products such as tea, coffee, pashmina, herbs and spices.
