**Press Release**

The Consulate General of Nepal in Chengdu organized an essay writing competition on 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> May 2026 among high school students of Chengdu No. 2 Middle School, also known as Chengdu Science and Technology High School.

The title of the essay competition was 'Nepal China relations: Global Peace'. A total of twenty students participated in the contest with an equal number of boys and girls. Contesting students expressed their views through essays on current Nepal China relations and what hopes they carried for the future. During the event, some students also spoke for short interviews regarding their experience of participating in such an event. The handwritten essays were judged through the three membered judge panel constituting from Chengdu Foreign Affairs office, teacher from the school and member from the consulate. The average score given by the panel declared Miss Huang Yaohui as the 1<sup>st</sup> winner.

On the second and final day of the event on 13<sup>th</sup> May, a formal ceremony was held in the auditorium hall of the school. Mr. Suresh Raut, Consul General; Mr. Wang Qian, Deputy Director of the Foreign Exchange Centre of Chengdu Municipal Bureau of Education; Principal Mr. Wang Guifei, Vice Principal Ms. Jiang Yuying, officials of the Consulate and other Nepali students were present on the occasion. 20 participating students as well as over 80 other students from the school were present during the event. The welcome remarks delivered by the consul touched upon the common grounds and values among Nepali and Chinese youths. A video showing the culture, nature and civilization of Nepal with subtitles in English and Mandarin was played during the event. The principal of the school, Mr. Wang Guifei delivered his remarks where he encouraged the students to utilize their skills with the pen to amplify voices advocating for global peace. A short video showing over hundred years of history of the school and the new Phoenix building premises was played. The Consul General. Mr. Suresh Raut delivered a keynote speech where he touched upon the historic ties between Nepal and China and expressed his belief that youths of both sides can play vital role in maintaining this relationship and in making the world a better place. General gave an interview to Chengdu plus, where he spoke about Consulate's effort to reach different sections of society in fostering bilateral relations to even a new height.

During the ceremony the winners of essays as the first, second and third position holders were presented with certificate, medals, cash prizes and a souvenir of Nepali style carved wooden window frame (*aankhijhyal*). All of the 17 participants were also given certificate of participation, medals and a souvenir. The first position holder read out her essay and shared her vision for global Peace.

In line with the theme of the event, a Nepali student from Sichuan University, Mr. Niraj Lawaju, performed a soulful rendition of the song '*jaha chhan buddha ka aankha*'. The school students performed a group song on '*We are the world; we are the children*'. The Consulate presented statues of Buddha as a token of appreciation to the school administration and the representative of Chengdu Municipal People's Government.

The event is the first of its kind where the consulate took a special approach to celebrating ***Buddha Poornima*** by partnering with a local public school in order to understand the voices and perspective of Chinese youth regarding global peace through the lens of Nepal-China relationship. The event garnered positive response from the school and the students with scope for greater cooperation in the future. The event was also covered by local media including Chengdu Plus television.
