The leader of the Nepali delegation Mr. Gobinda Bahadur Karkee, Secretary of the Office of the Prime Minister and Council of Ministers of Nepal today addressed the plenary session of 11th Session of the Conference of States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption (UNCAC) themed 'Shaping Tomorrow's Integrity' in Doha, Qatar which commenced from yesterday. The conference is regarded as the world's largest gathering dedicated to combating corruption.

In his statement during the session, Secretary Mr. Karkee highlighted efforts and commitments of the Interim Government of Nepal formed following the historic public movement aimed at promoting good governance and controlling corruption. He added that the current government has adopted a strict zero-tolerance policy against corruption, and pursued robust legal, administrative and institutional reforms.

Reaffirming Nepal's unwavering commitment to the United Nations Convention against Corruption, he shed light on the obligations of Financial Action Task Force (FATF) Action Plan, and the Second National Strategy and Action Plan against Corruption being finalized.

Secretary Mr. Karkee further stressed on the measures taken by the Government in criminalizing bribery, abuse of authority, illicit enrichment, money laundering, and related offences in line with UNCAC.

Other members of the delegation comprise Dr. Bhishma Kumar Bhusal, Joint Secretary from the Office of the Prime Minister and Council of Ministers, Mr. Kumar Rai, Chargé d'Affaires and Mr. Amar Rai, First Secretary from the Embassy of Nepal in Doha.
