The Consulate General of Nepal in Chengdu organized '18th Republic Day and 72nd International Sagarmatha Day' on 29 May.

The event was attended by Ms. Wang Zheng, Director of Consular Affairs Division of Foreign Affairs Office of Sichuan Province; Ms. Ran Hongbo, Deputy Director of International Exchange and Cooperation Division of Department of Culture and Tourism and other members from these agencies.

The event began with the national anthem of both countries, followed by a minute of silence in honour of the martyrs who sacrificed their lives for the establishment of democracy and republic in Nepal. The Consul General read the message from Rt. Hon. President and Rt. Hon. Prime Minister issued on the occasion of Republic Day.

In his remarks, the Consul General highlighted the socio-economic advances that have been made in the last eighteen years, while reiterating the importance of safeguarding and strengthening the Republic by its leadership, citizens and institutions. He also emphasized on Sagarmatha's identity as a global natural heritage and the unique identity of the 'Sherpas'.

Brief remarks from a representative of Nepali community based in Chengdu, was made during the event which touch upon the impact of republic and crucial interlinkage of Sagarmatha to every Nepali person's identity. The event also saw reading of excerpts from the 'Sagarmatha Call for Action'- the outcome from the Sagarmatha Sambad held by Government of Nepal from 16-18 May in Kathmandu.

The flag at the Consulate premises was hoisted in the morning by the Consul General in the presence of all consulate staff. The event was attended by 60 people from Nepali and Chinese communities.
