The Consulate General of Nepal in Chengdu hosted an event in Chongqing to commemorate 70 years of diplomatic bilateral relations between Nepal and China.

The series of events began with exhibition of Nepali niche products like tea, coffee, felt, pashmina, incense, singing bowl, thangka, etc. at the 2nd ILSTC High-Quality Products Exhibition and Cooperation Fair on December 11 in Chongqing. A segment on cultural exchange included playing traditional instrument 'Guqin' from the Chinese side and two ethnic dance performances from Nepali university students.

On December 12, the formal event titled '*Bridging the Himalayas: Unleashing the Treasure of Civilization*' was hosted by the Consulate and International Communication and Cooperation Alliance (ICCA) at the World Financial Centre in Chongqing with the support of Yuzhong District Government of Chongqing. The event was attended by Mr. Deng Guanghuai, Executive Deputy District Chief of Yuzhong District Government, Chongqing; and Ms. Fan Min, Deputy Director General-Level Inspector from Foreign Affairs Office of Chongqing Municipality, along with over fifty participants including businessperson and media personnels.

The event began with a charming cultural performance from both sides, followed by opening remarks by the Consul General, and Executive Deputy District Chief- charting out the history of Nepal China relations and avenues of future cooperation between Nepal and Chongqing. The Consulate also awarded the plaque of **Nepal National Pavilion** to ICCA for a permanent exhibition area to be established in Chongqing for showcasing Nepali products. This would be the fourth pavilion of its kind within the Consulate's jurisdictional area, and the first in Chongqing.

A comprehensive and nuanced thematic presentation on Nepali tourism sector was delivered by Mr. Laxman Gautam, Director, from Nepal Tourism Board. Mr. Anoop Ranjan Bhattarai, President of Nepal China Executive Council spoke on the economic and trade exchanges between Nepal and China.
