The Consulate General of Nepal in Lhasa is pleased to announce that emergency relief supplies from the Xizang Autonomous Region of the People's Republic of China were officially handed over to Nepal today at Nechung/Lizi (Korala) Port.

The assistance primarily comprises specialized equipment, including Bailey panels, reinforced suspension rods, support frames, bridge decking and I-beams, sufficient to assemble two Bailey bridges. These will be deployed to help restore critical transportation links and support ongoing rescue and relief operations in areas of Nepal affected by mudslides.

A bilingual banner was displayed at the handover ceremony reflecting the spirit of solidarity between the two nations.

On the same day in the morning, a formal handover and signing ceremony was held at the Consulate General of Nepal in Lhasa between the Foreign Affairs Office of the Xizang Autonomous Region and the Consulate General of Nepal. The handover documents were formally signed by Mr. Laxmi Prasad Niraula, Consul General of Nepal in Lhasa, and Mr. Ouyang Zhibing, Deputy Director General of the Foreign Affairs Office of the Xizang Autonomous Region.

"As time-tested friends and neighbors, we are always there in times of need, and this swift assistance stands as a testament to our unwavering solidarity with Nepal", said Mr. Ouyang Zhibing, Deputy Director General of the Foreign Affairs Office of the Xizang Autonomous Region

Consul General Mr. Niraula expressed the Government and people of Nepal's deep appreciation for the swift and timely assistance extended by the Xizang Autonomous Region in the wake of the disaster. He noted that this support once again demonstrates the enduring friendship and mutual solidarity between Nepal and China, two neighbors bound by shared mountains and rivers and united in times of hardship.
