The Consulate General of Nepal in Lhasa successfully organized a special event at the Everest Base Camp on the Tibetan side of the Xizang Autonomous Region from 7 to 9 June 2026, in cooperation with the Foreign Affairs Office of the Xizang Autonomous Region of the People's Republic of China. The program was held to commemorate Sagarmatha Day 2026.

The event provided a valuable platform to celebrate the shared natural and cultural heritage of the Himalayan region and to further strengthen friendly relations between Nepal and China. It also highlighted the importance of sustainable tourism development in the Everest region.

During the visit, the Consulate General held a fruitful meeting with senior officials of the Local Government of Shigatse Prefecture and representatives of travel and tourism agencies. The discussion was focused on promoting Nepal-Tibet tourism cooperation, enhancing connectivity, and exploring joint initiatives to attract more visitors to experience the Himalayan destinations on both sides of the border.

During the program, Mr. Laxmi Prasad Niraula, Consul General of Nepal in Lhasa, highlighted the serious impact of climate change on the Himalayas, including glacial melting, biodiversity loss, and risks to fragile ecosystems. The Consul General also emphasized the importance of joint Nepal-China initiatives to address these common challenges through sustainable development practices and enhanced regional cooperation.

The participating officials from the Chinese side expressed their appreciation for the initiative and reaffirmed their commitment to advancing bilateral tourism promotion and cooperation. The successful conclusion of the program is expected to further consolidate the longstanding bonds of friendship and cooperation between the two countries.
