Honorable Ms. Rubi Kumari, Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives of Nepal, has concluded a six-day official visit to the Xizang Autonomous Region of the People's Republic of China, from July 15 to 20, 2026, to participate in the 5th China Xizang Trans-Himalaya Forum for International Cooperation. The Deputy Speaker returned to Kathmandu today, marking the successful completion of her engagement.

During the forum held in Nyingchi, Hon'ble Deputy Speaker delivered remarks at the opening ceremony and keynote forum, highlighting the importance of strengthening connectivity, cultural linkages, and mutually beneficial cooperation across the Trans-Himalayan region.

During her engagement in Nyingchi, Hon'ble Deputy Speaker held a bilateral meeting with the high-level leaders of the Xizang Autonomous Region of China led by H.E. Mr. Wang Junzheng, Party Secretary of the Xizang Autonomous Regional Committee of the Communist Party of China. The discussions centered on strengthening existing bilateral ties, enhancing mutual cooperation, and exploring opportunities to strengthen Nepal-China relations on a regional scale.

Reaffirming Nepal's steadfast commitment to the One-China Principle, Hon'ble Deputy Speaker expressed Nepal's keen interest in expanding cooperation with China across multiple sectors, including infrastructure development, trade and investment, energy, and tourism, particularly within the framework of the Belt and Road Initiative.

Following the conclusion of the forum's main events in Nyingchi, the delegation travelled to Lhasa, where the Consulate General of Nepal in Lhasa hosted a dinner in honour of the Hon'ble Deputy Speaker and the delegation.

The visit included engagements in Lhasa and a journey to Ngari (Ali) Prefecture, where the Hon'ble Deputy Speaker paid respects at the sacred sites of Mount Kailash and Lake Manasarovar. In Lhasa, she visited the Potala Palace and Jokhang Temple, the Women's Council of Nanga Community in Duilong District, and the Lhasa Comprehensive Bonded Zone, reflecting the region's progress in governance, heritage preservation, and economic development.
