On the auspicious occasion of the 2569th Buddha Purnima, The Embassy of Nepal, Bangkok together with Nepal Tourism Board is organizing various programs in Bangkok. Today in the morning an "Interaction with stakeholders about -Lumbini and Communities around the world Heritage Sites" program was held at the Hotel Annantara Siam, Bangkok.

Addressing the program, H.E. Mr. Dhan Bahadur Oli, Ambassador of Nepal to the Kingdom of Thailand highlighted the historical, cultural, socio-economic facets of Lumbini, and he further underscored the importance of collaboration and partnership among the key stakeholders for the promotion of Lumbini in collaboration with local communities around the world heritage sites of the birthplace of Lord Buddha.

Honorable Mr. Prachand Bikram Neupane, Minister for Ministry of Industry Tourism and Transport, Lumbini Province Dang expressed his commitment to play coordinating role for the promotion and development of Lumbini and the communities around together with Local and federal governments.
