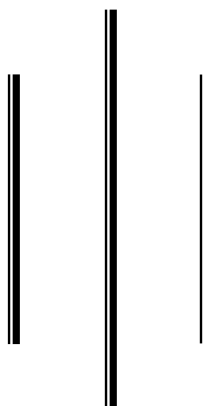




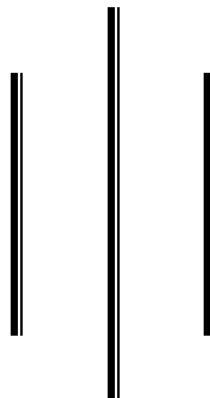

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Preface

Nepal has been mobilizing external development finance through grants and concessional loans received from bilateral and multilateral development partners. In addition, the country has also been utilizing financial and technical assistance provided by international non-governmental organizations (INGOs).

The Financial Procedure and Fiscal Responsibility Act, 2019 requires that details of both domestic and external sources be incorporated while presenting expenditure estimates. Under foreign assistance, financial, technical, and in-kind support received by the Government from bilateral countries, multilateral, international and regional organizations, philanthropic institutions, and other global funds for the development and construction of various sectors are included. Information relating to foreign grants and loans mobilized through Nepal's national budget system is incorporated in the Statement of Expenditure Estimates (Red Book). Likewise, for the purpose of reporting technical and other assistance mobilized outside the budget system, the Government of Nepal has continued its longstanding practice of publicly disclosing details of technical and other assistance during the annual budget presentation.

In this context, the publication of details relating to technical and other assistance-incorporating assistance received from sectoral ministries and development partners, as well as support mobilized by international non-governmental organizations through the Social Welfare Council-has been continued since previous fiscal years. This edition includes the estimated details of assistance expected to be received in Fiscal Year 2083/84. In the context of political transformations brought about by the Gen Z movement and the subsequent general elections, as well as the growing demand for institutional accountability and governance reform, the current Government has placed economic modernization, high public accountability, and the protection of human capital at the center of its development priorities.

Under technical assistance, development partners provide financial, in-kind, service-based, or blended support in areas such as skills, knowledge, awareness, innovation, entrepreneurship, policy, law, systems, procedures, and technology at the individual, institutional, and social levels. Such assistance is primarily intended to help address national capacity gaps through studies, training, consultancy services, equipment, and logistical support. The Foreign Aid Mobilization Policy, 2082 has adopted a selective approach toward the utilization of technical assistance to fulfill gaps in national capacity and expertise. The policy further prioritizes unconditional technical assistance, discourages the use of loans except for project-related technical assistance, and provides for the mobilization of international and regional technical assistance based on national needs and benefits.

This document has been prepared with the objective of ensuring accurate reporting of all forms of development assistance received by the Government of Nepal from development partners and avoiding duplication in reporting. In addition to the technical assistance formally approved for mobilization by development partners, this publication also includes technical and other assistance that may be mobilized during Fiscal Year 2083/84 based on ongoing discussions and information received to date.
