Subject: Regarding Temporary Import Vehicle (TIV) Declaration

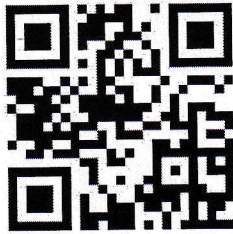
As per the decision of the Department of Customs, owners of the foreign vehicles should make a self-declaration through the NNSW (Nepal's National Single Window) for the TIV Declaration starting from 27th May 2026 A.D. (B.S. 2083.02.13).

The owner of the vehicle must present at the Customs Officer Desk at passenger gate (Yatru Section, MCH02) for the verification of the vehicle and the following documents:

1. Vehicle Registration Certificate (RC Card)
2. Driving License (DL)
3. Identification document of the vehicle owner

The TIV Declaration can be generated by the scanning of the following QR code below or through <https://nnsw.gov.np/tiv/gen/>. The Free wifi zone is available inside the office premises at TIV Zone too.

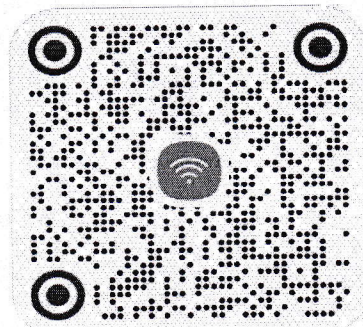
